


Worcestershire 2010



- Pressure on specialist service
- Inconsistency of approach, resource, need, and service delivery but no means of understand in a coherent way
- Duplication of effort
- No strategic framework
- No clear service specification
- Virtually no outcomes only input measures (face to face contacts)
- Gaps in service delivery and waiting list pressures
- Inconsistent services to schools

- Resource allocation tool














Understand map of provision and balance of provision





The % of ECaT supported practitioners who understood how to use strategies to support children's speech and language development (ECaT 12)






