NEW WAYS OF WORKING AS A RESULT OF THE BALANCED SYSTEM®		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Embedded a Family Support Package which included 6 Stay and Play sessions for nursery parents and 1 for parents of pupils in the early years. The Stay and Play sessions focussed on adult/child interaction.</li> <li>• Key staff are up skilled in adult/child interactions</li> <li>• The nursery has gained a Silver Award for developing an excellent spoken communication environment.</li> <li>• The school has achieved a Silver Award for developing an excellent visual communication environment.</li> <li>• All staff have had access to a range of formal and informal development opportunities covering topics such as Communication Environment, practical Interventions and Word Aware.</li> <li>• Interventions such as Nursery Narrative, teaching children to listen, fun with narrative and colourful semantics are effectively embedded in the early years curriculum.</li> </ul>
