

Scoring System to Support the AssetPlus SLCN Screening tool.

The AssetPlus is a Government document and so I am unable to make any direct amendments to this. However, in order to make the screening process more relevant and to aid Speech and Language intervention and support, we have devised a scoring system that you can apply to the form yourself on completion. This will then aid you in the referral process. (See supporting document for the referral pathway/process).

Scoring the AssetPlus:

Yes = 2 points

No = 0 points

Sometimes =1 point.

A **total score of 20+** means refer direct to Speech and Language Therapy (see the SLT referral pathway).

A **total score of 16-20**; discuss with the Speech and Language Therapist. There may be some red flags that would warrant a speech and language assessment or it may be that specific advice is required to help make the work you do easier for the YP to access.

Score below 16 may require advice. In this case a referral isn't needed but after discussion with the SLT, there may be further areas that need exploring in more depth.

If there are any red flags; irrespective of anything else, you will need to refer to speech and language.

Red Flags: Under Sections: speaking 1,2,4; Understanding 2,3 Social Communication 3,5.

If there is any pre identified SEN ticked in relation to SLCN, ASD, MLD, SLD adaptations will need to be made for the Young Person. Please seek advice from the Speech and Language Therapist.

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
